




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Straight From

THE STARE DOWN!

Sometimes we get all fired up with our dreams and visions and have that good feeling that we are set to hit the targets that we have set for ourselves, but then out of nowhere, challenges arise that engage us in a stare down.

Quite a while ago, when I had just finished high school and had written and passed the entry exams into college (university), it seemed as though every attempt I made at getting accepted by the schools of my choice were met with stiff opposition, it was as though I was engaged in a stare down with this situation. It was a question of 'who was going to blink first'. Ultimately God made a way where there seemed to be no way.

The real issue in these kinds of situations is not the stare down itself, but rather would I allow the challenge that I faced to triumph in the stare down or do I triumph over the stare down ensuring that I do not blink first.

The Bible admonishes us to stand firm after having done all to stand. Relating this to the stare down, we need to stare after having done all to stare.

One question however that rings so true is this – have you done all to stand? If you haven't done all to stand, then most likely you aren't ready for the stare down. Doing all to stand involves a great deal, just like the athlete who goes through rigorous training to build on his endurance and stamina, we must also go through the process of getting ready to stand the stare down.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

POSSESS DEEP ROOTS

You can very easily figure out what tree would stand the storms by the depths of its roots. Without roots, you cannot stand, without roots, you cannot bear fruits.

THE DEEPER YOUR ROOTS EXTEND INTO THE SOURCE OF LIFE, THE MORE YOU ARE GUARANTEED A VICTORY OVER THE STARE DOWN.

Possessing deep roots will require an 'INTENTIONAL LIVING'. Everything you do or undertake to do must be intentional towards developing your roots which would in turn guarantee your victory over the challenges of life, Paul captured it accurately: "looking away from all that will distract us and] focusing our eyes on Jesus, who is the Author and Perfecter of faith [the first incentive for our belief and the One who brings our faith to maturity], who for the joy [of accomplishing the goal] set before Him endured the cross, disregarding the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God [revealing His deity, His authority, and the completion of His work].

Your depth determines your placement in life, another key way to possess deep roots is by being immersed in the Word of God. You must be so inclined to meditating on the Word of God that it becomes the food that satisfies your hunger and the water that quenches your thirst. The Psalmist puts it this way, "How sweet are thy words unto my taste! Yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth (Psalm 119:103).

Just like the roots of a tree derives its nourishment from the nutrients in the soil, your spiritual roots will need her nourishment from the Word of God.

In addition to living intentional and

going after the Word of God, the third thing that you must do is to <u>convert</u> <u>your language to the language of faith</u>. Faith comes by hearing the Word of God (Romans 10:17). In other words, when you make the Word of God the longing of your heart, faith comes. However you will need to receive and work that faith, for faith without works is dead.

Speaking the language of faith means responding just like Jesus would have done.

Jesus spoke the truth which is the Word of God to all situations. When the challenge speaks words of doubts and fear, you must respond with words of faith and courage knowing fully well that God's words are full of power, backed by Heaven and cannot fail.

("For the word of God is living and active and full of power [making it operative, energizing, and effective]. It is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating as far as the division of the soul and spirit [the completeness of a person], and of both joints and marrow [the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and judging the very thought and intentions of the heart" Hebrews 4:12 AMP).

STAND YOUR GROUND

Recently I took interest in studying a bit of the stand your ground law that is applicable to a couple of states in the United States of America.

This law permits a person in a residence in which he has the right to be in, to refuse to retreat and has the right to stand his or her ground and use or threaten to use non-deadly/deadly force under certain conditions.

This law sounds so similar to Paul's admonition in the book of Ephesians 6:13, 14. "And having done all to stand, stand therefore..."

IT IS OUR GOD GIVEN RIGHT TO REFUSE TO RETREAT AS LONG AS WE ARE STANDING ON THE WORD OF GOD.

In addition to this we possess the right to utilize the weapons of our warfare which aren't carnal in the defence of our God given position and promise as we have seen in the word of God and by revelation.

However just like the American 'stand your ground' law comes with some prerequisites, the Kingdom of God's 'stand your ground law' also comes with its own prerequisites.

Paul summarizes these prerequisites as follows: "In conclusion, be strong in the Lord [draw your strength from Him and be empowered through your union with Him] and in the power of His [boundless] might. Put on the full armour of God [for His precepts are like the splendid armour of a heavily-armed soldier], so that you may be able to [successfully] stand up against all the schemes and the strategies and the deceits of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood [contending only with physical opponents], but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this [present] darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly (supernatural) places. Therefore,

put on the complete armour of God, so that you will be able to [successfully] resist and stand your ground in the evil day [of danger], and having done everything [that the crisis demands], to stand firm [in your place, fully prepared, immovable, victorious]. So stand firm and hold your ground, having tightened the wide band of truth (personal integrity, moral courage) around your waist and having put on the breastplate of righteousness (an upright heart), and



having strapped on your feet the gospel of peace in preparation [to face the enemy with firm-footed stability and the readiness produced by the good news]. Above all, lift up the [protective] shield of faith with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. With all prayer and petition pray [with specific requests] at all times [on every occasion and in every season] in the Spirit, and with this in view, stay alert with all perseverance and petition [interceding in prayer] for all God's people" Ephesians 6:10-18. God has promised that we are more than conquerors through Christ who loved us.

This just means that in our pursuit to gain deep roots, live intentionally, meditate on the Word, speak the language of faith and stand our ground, we must always realize that we can only prosper in these things and emerge victorious if we do all we do through Jesus Christ.

This is the bedrock of our salvation – this is the way to triumph over the stare down!

He killed Stephen who was also a deacon and attacked many others from their homes. This caused many people to migrate including Phillip. They were forced to move, so to speak, to save their lives. Phillip moved to Samaria and the responsibility of being the apostle over the people in Samaria inadvertently fell on him. Prior to this, his duties involved sharing food to orphans and widows. Now in Samaria, he was preaching, healing the sick and performing miracles. Things he never knew he had in him but which the situation forced out of him.



One of Phillip's major achievement was leading Simon, the magician to Christ. Before Phillip moved to Samaria Simon had dazzled the people with magic and had a large following. He not only believed in the gospel of Christ but got baptized by Phillip. This meant that all his followers automatically became Christians too.

There was also an Ethiopian eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of Ethiopia who was in charge of all her treasures. Phillip through the leading of the Holy Spirit ministered the gospel of Jesus to him and also baptized him. I believe he in turn must have gone to Ethiopia to spread the good news. If Phillip had not taken charge of an unanticipated adversity and situation, how would he have met an important personality from Ethiopia? He was in Samaria but through him, the gospel got to Ethiopia. Sometimes, the adversity is not about you. DESTINIES ARE CONNECTED TO THE FULFILMENT OF YOUR OWN DESTINY.

Phillip's own daughters, I believe by their father's influence began to



Adversity will show you who you really are, what you are capable of and the things you did not even know about yourself. Adversity is a good thing. Adversity is the time to show the world who you are and what you carry and not to cower. REMEMBER, GOD GIVES THE TOUGHEST BATTLES TO HIS STRONGEST SOLDIERS.
